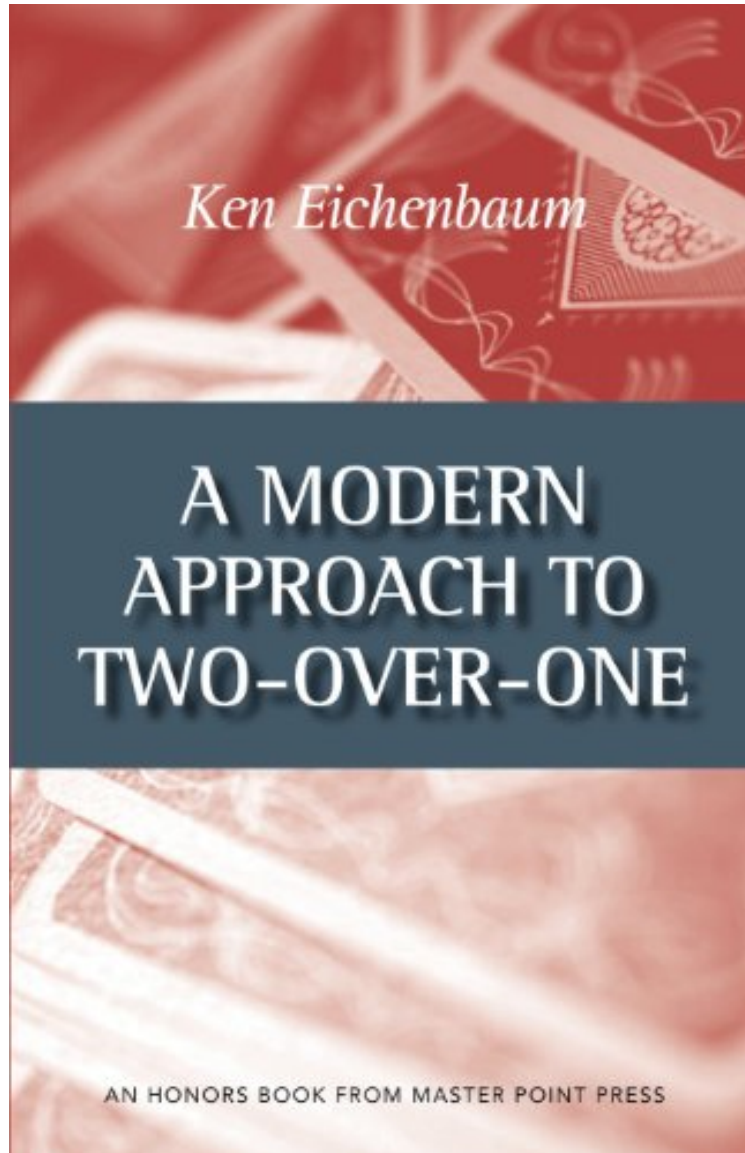

Our success with these methods have been great, including in the very highest levels of competition. This book will not necessarily develop everything about how to think or

analyze hands, as that does not seem to be his main focus. Rather, the book offers a set of tools for partnerships to use. The author assumes a level of competence that one would have to possess to even start thinking along the lines of improving specific sequences in 2/1 GF in the first place, so why tell you what you presumably already know? Rather, his tools seem to allow you to finally use the skills that you probably already possess more effectively. That said, some of the ideas might seem foreign, in that focus is on something you might not have realized to have importance, which makes you think, "Why?" This is unquestionably the UGLIEST book I have ever read. The type-setting is horrible, and the organisation amateurish. However, if you can get past the UGLY factor, there are lots of gadgets for advanced 2/1 players. It is only 122 pages long, and written in a style that requires a good knowledge of bidding. It is best suited for advanced club players and stronger; the intermediate club player will not be ready to incorporate many of the gadgets in this book.

A Modern Approach to Two-Over-One was written for the player who already uses a basic two-over-one approach, but is looking for more comprehensive methods to "glue" his system together.
