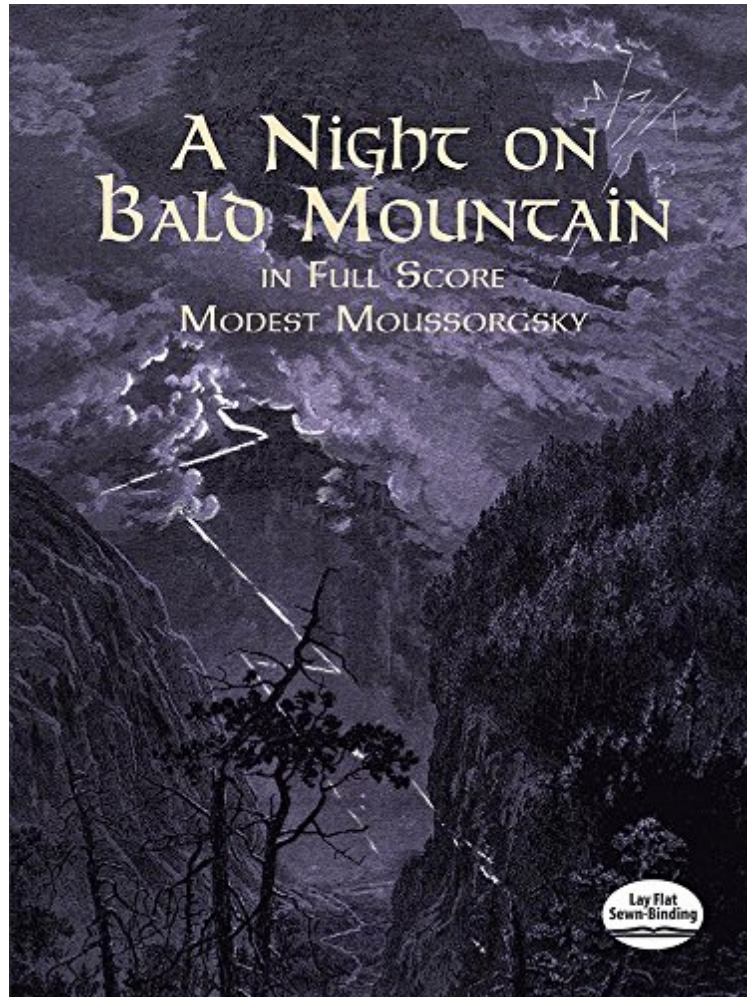

Simpson To correct the previous reviewer's comment about this work being "just the way Moussorgsky wrote it", this reviewer would like to point out that the Dover score is a reprint of Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov's arrangement and orchestration. While a brilliant and deservedly popular work in its own right, Rimsky's arrangement was prepared about 5 years after the composer's death and bears only the most superficial resemblance to

Mussorgsky's 1867 score (full title: St. John's Night on the Bare Mountain). This enduringly popular work has been carefully reproduced from an early authoritative score for this handsome, inexpensive edition.
