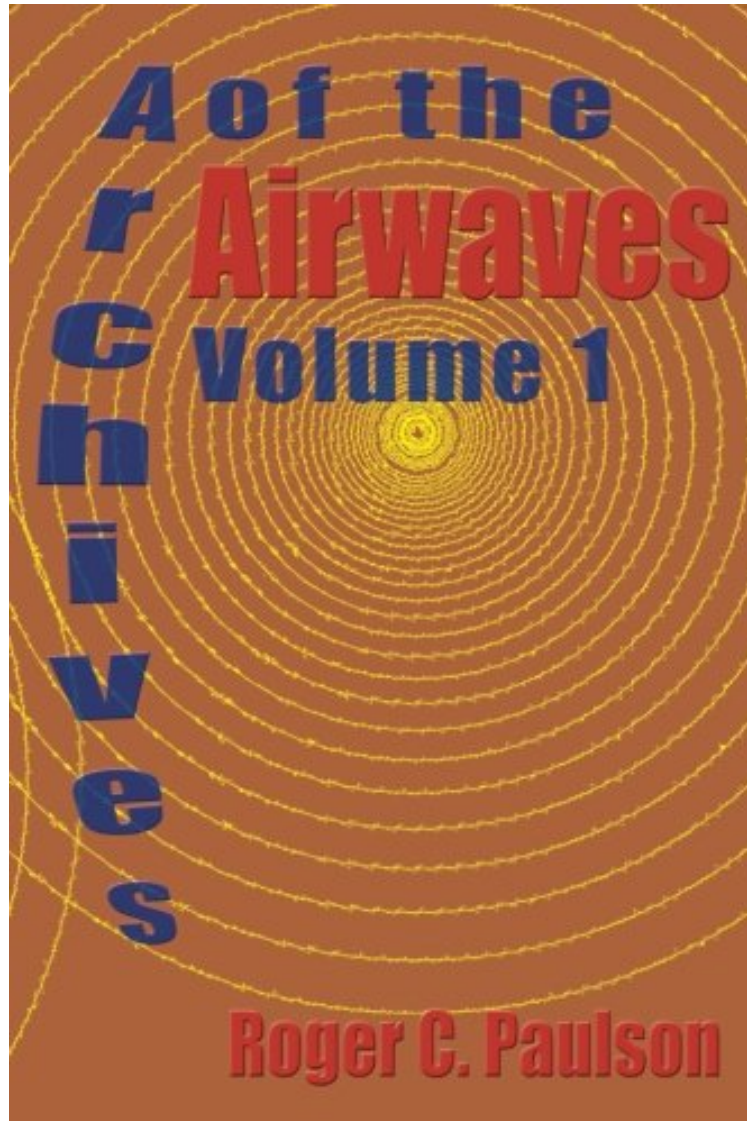

There's also a considerable bit of anecdotal information that is erroneous. Mind you, this is a massive and impressive undertaking. But I tried to read through it as I do most OTR-related books, but it was very hard to get very far before putting it

down and requesting a refund. Which is a shame, because I was looking forward to this series of books, both as a research tool and a casual reading experience. Hopefully the publisher will reformat it properly for electronic devices and re-issue it sometime in the future.

At least seven times the size of John Dunning's *On the Air*, this massive tome has been 20 years in the making and is a **MUST** for any fan of radio history.
