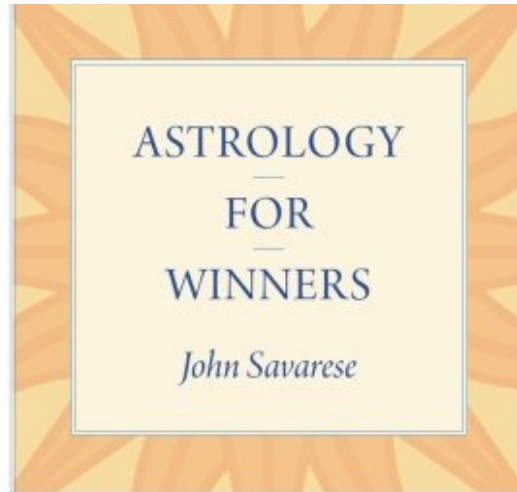

This book provides the tools you need to pick a horse with the tendency to be the winner in a thoroughbred or harness race as these races have numbered post positions in their starting gates (in this book, we focus on thoroughbred racing). Basically you will need to create a chart of the race using the date, place and time of the race before the actual day of the race. You must then analyze this chart using the guidelines set forth in this book, including the use of lunar mansions, in order to see the planetary body in the most powerful position in the chart. This planetary body has a post position number in the race. You then pick the horse in that post position, and support picking this horse using the additional information in this book. With the WIN strategy and other tools presented, you as an astrologer, person

interested in astrology, or horse-race player with a willingness to learn some astrology will have an excellent chance of picking the horse that has the best tendency to win a race. And if you are a student of Astrology and prefer not to wager on races, you will certainly learn a lot about horse-racing. The instructions, which are clearly written, are provided along with most everything you need to implement the WIN strategy: opening a wagering account getting past performance data to support your pick, including the advice of expert handicappers dealing with the management of post positions at different racetracks, which involves scratched horses and two-part/three-part entries knowing if a race is a good one to wager on knowing if you are lucky that day knowing how to place bets to get the most money from your pick knowing the payoff s from various odds and even knowing how to watch the race on TV.
