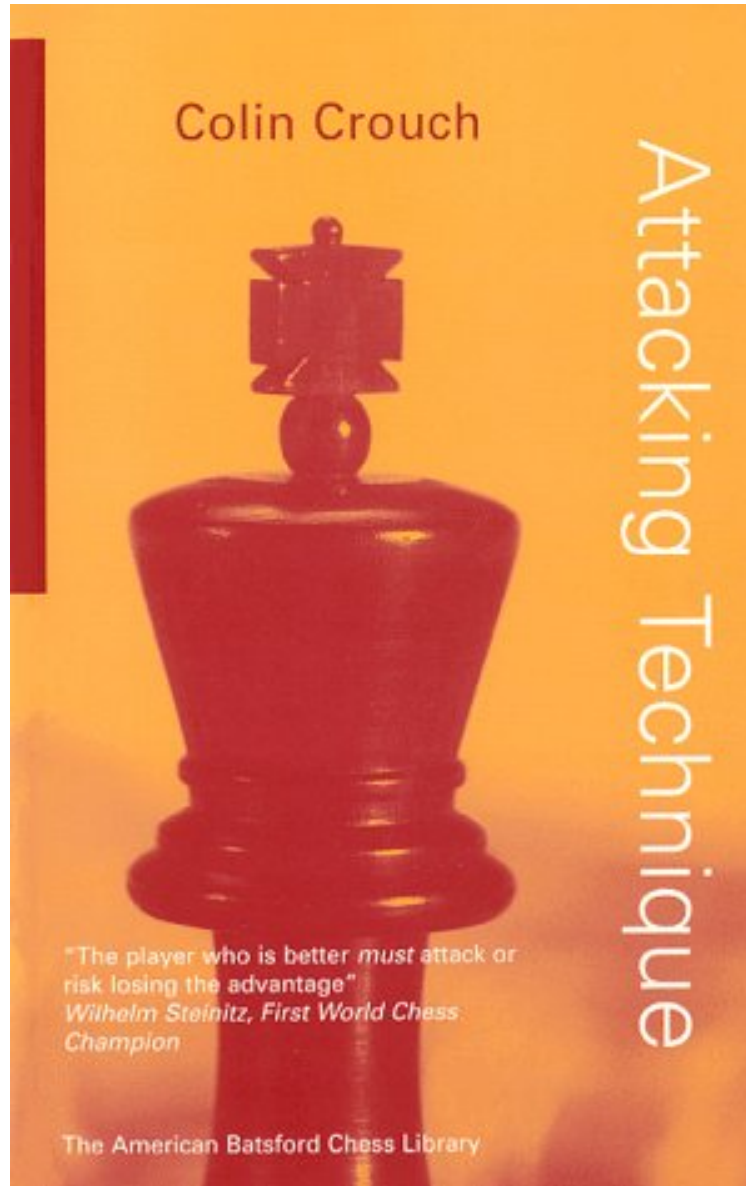

It talked about not launching an attack with two pieces only, about launching an attack when your position is favorable, before the position neutralizes. Then I get to the sample games. On of the games was just full of blunders.

One blunder is ok, but it could be a critical point in game but several blunders in the same game does not make it the best for studying, bc it basically became about spotting the blunder then how to engage an appropriate attack against an opponent that doesn't blunder so many times. Then in another game it was not even about attacking, the game was about an endgame struggle, which is fine if you were studying endgames, but not a great idea for people learning to exploit imbalances with an attack.
