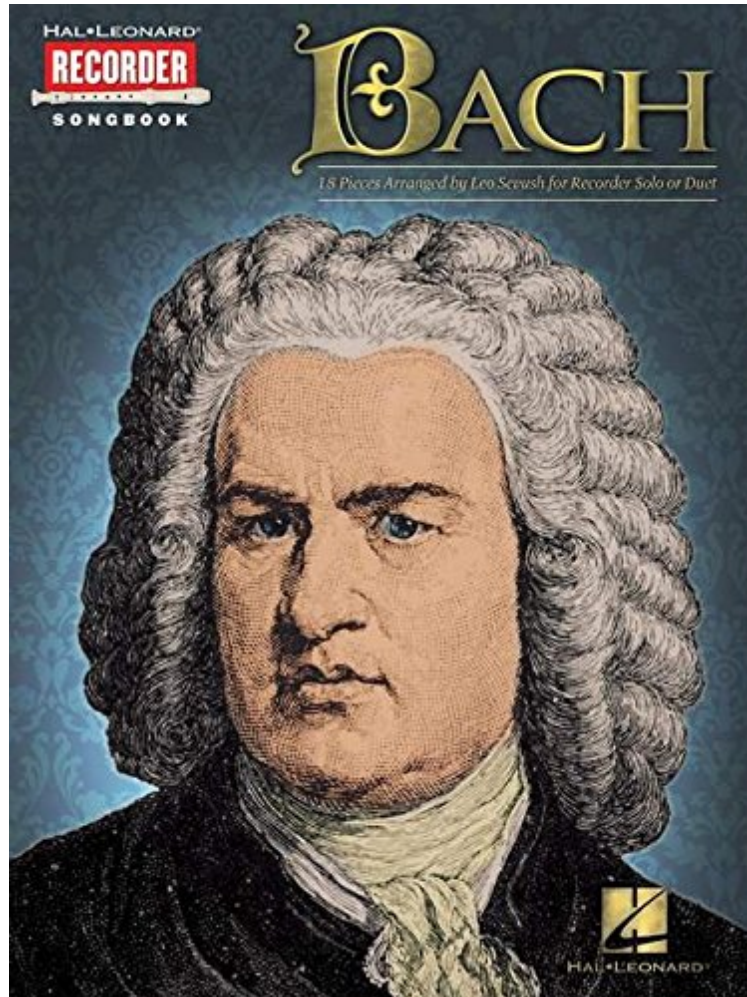

I'm not a huge classical music buff so I can't say "This has all my favorites!" but it does have a bunch I like. I also like the progression of songs. They add a little bit more each time to work on. Don't buy this if you're afraid of practicing the second octave on the recorder. You will be hitting the high B in the very first song. All the songs are duets for two C recorders though I've found it's easier to use the Alto in F w/ some of the accompaniment because of some wonky accidentals that are tricky on C recorders. This isn't a beginners book. Again, I would say if you can hit that high B you're probably ready for this.
