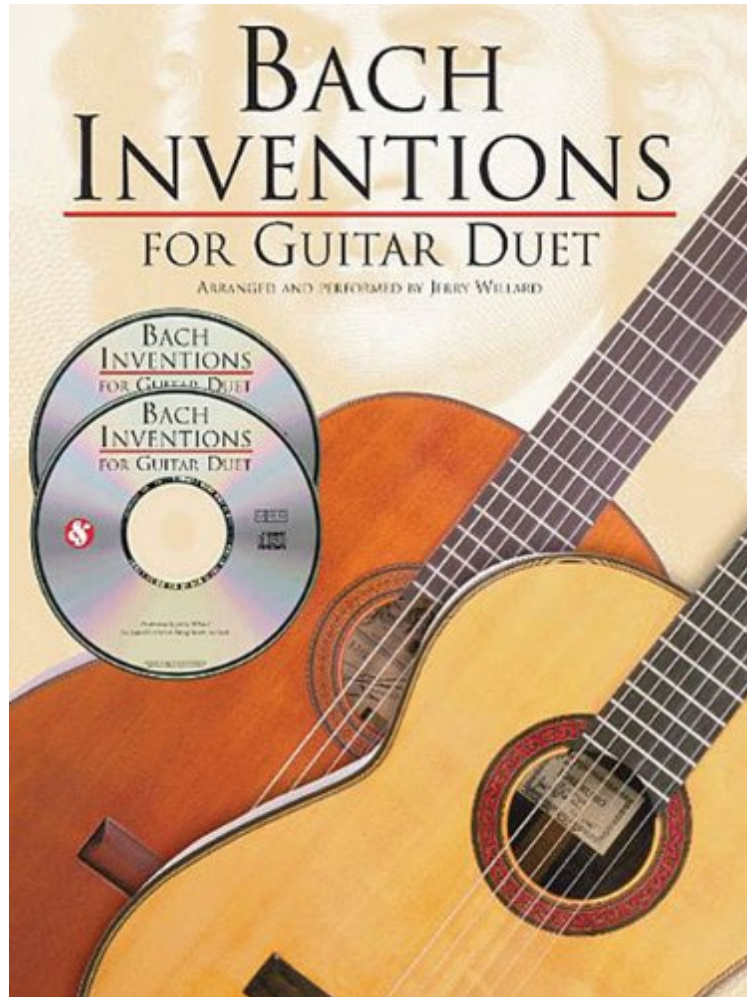

The title is accompanied by two CDs, the first of which features demonstration recordings of all inventions. The second CD offers single guitar recordings so you can play along.
