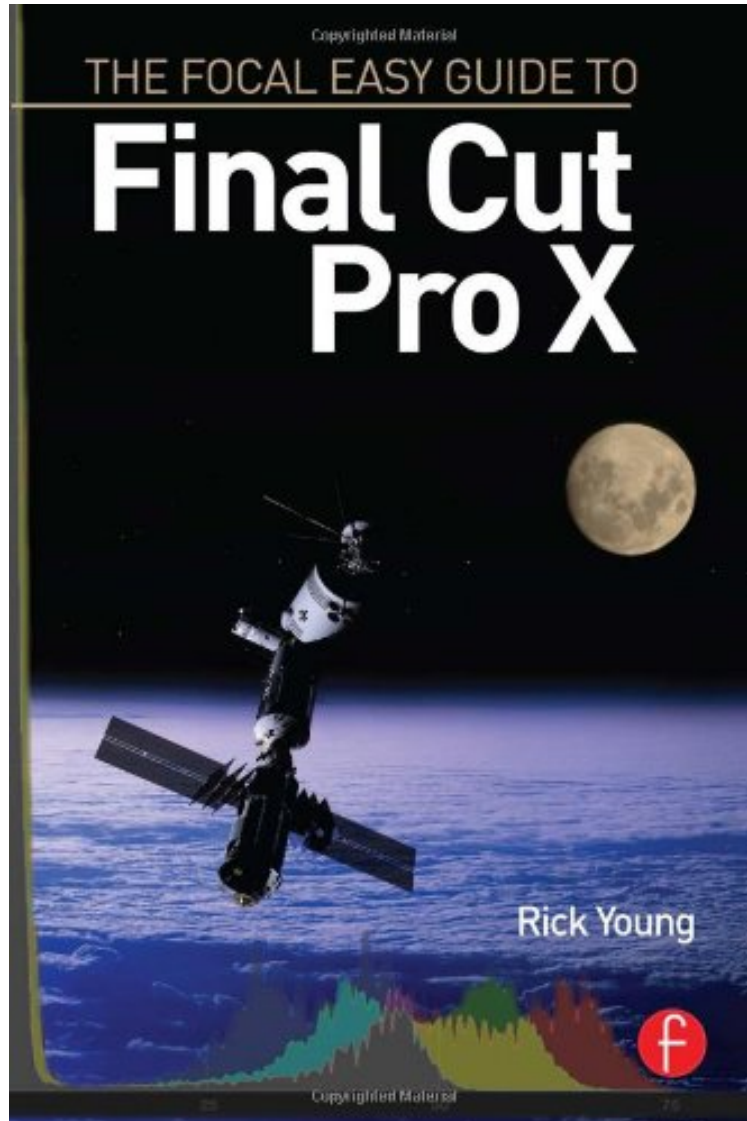

This doesn't cause too many issues, but some of the images and a couple basic instructions aren't accurate when working with the latest build of Final Cut Pro.
