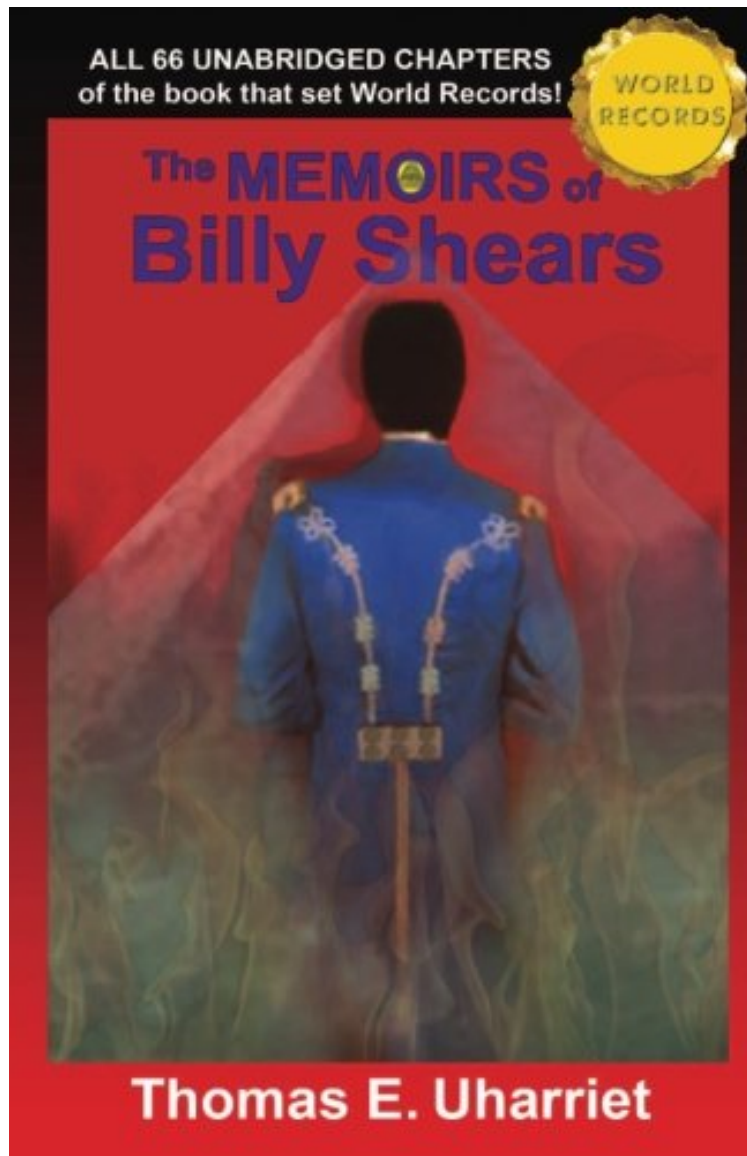

Too many real people (many still alive, some famous, including Mick Jagger and the recently-deceased George Martin) are named as having knowledge of the switch for it to not be. "Billy Shears" even addresses the children Paul fathered, and explains the results of the paternity suit. These are real people. I can't see anyone making up a fiction about these sensitive topics, and I don't think that occurred here, either. I don't want to give it away, but you simply can't say the things he says to them unless you're an irresponsible, lying sociopath who'd end up in a libel suit or you're actually speaking the truth. The book tells the reader in several ways that it is "fiction" for legal purposes, but then specifies what has been fictionalized ... and not much has. When I was little- too young to understand the lyrics- I always thought even up-tempo Beatles music was very sad. Now that I've read this book, I see that much of their music was indeed full of grieving. Kids know things that adults talk themselves out of. I started this book interested in a conspiracy.
