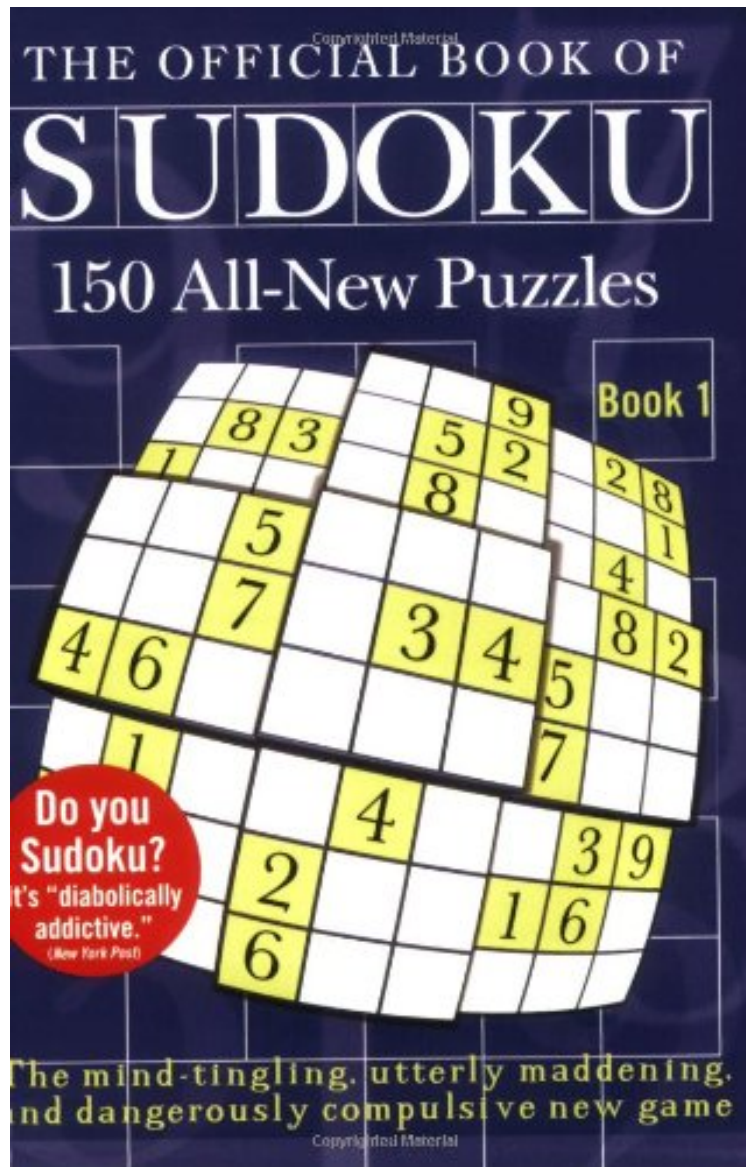

Started doing Sudoku in Sunday paper. First one was the Samari style, and I was hooked. Purchased this along with several other Sudoku puzzle books from , including one for my 13 year old daughter who is also getting hooked. Only complaint about this book is that I wish the puzzle boxes were larger!

The name of the game is Sudoku, Japanese for "number place," but no knowledge of Japanese language or arithmetic is required to enjoy the game that has sparked a mania around the world. Its a fever that is now spreading to the United States, as readers of the New York Post and Los Angeles Times can readily attest. Veterans of other highly-addictive logic games such as Rubiks cube, Tetris, or Minesweeper will love the fresh challenge of Sudoku. Its a wordless logic crossword that leaves even the most dedicated puzzle enthusiasts scratching their heads. Here in one volume is all you need to get started
150 Sudoku puzzles (and solutions) along with easy-to-follow instructions and strategies. Solve these entirely with logic and youll arrive at the right answer but be warned: the more you solve, the more youll want to play!
To solve, fill-in the blanks with the digits 1 through 9 in such a way that each digit appears in each column, row, and 3 x 3 box only once. You need numbers, but no math is involved.
