Then I fell in love with the puzzle and started hunting for collections of codeword puzzles. I'd put The Times Codeword Book 1 in the middle of the pack. The print is smaller, the lines not as sharp, and I don't like that, in addition to the clues filled in on the 1-26

grid, they print the given letters in three spaces. Also, you should know that The Times is a British newspaper, so the spellings are British spellings. My most favorite book of codewords, also purchased from , is from Clarity Media. The paper is whiter and the lines are crisper. My least favorite is Classic Codeword Puzzles by Lubandi. As in The Times' volume, the paper is yellower and the lines muddier; plus, they put the answers to another puzzle at the bottom of the page -- very distracting.
