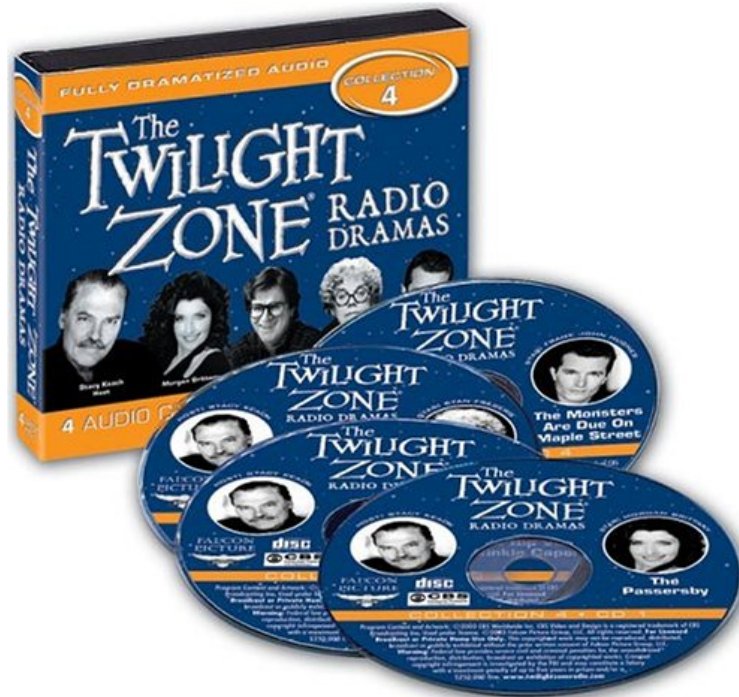

"The Monsters Are Due On Maple Street" Starring Frank John Hughes. The residents of a quiet street suspect an alien invasion is imminent and that one of their own is a monster leading the attack.

From AudioFile Actor Stacy Keach hosts this collection of radio dramas. The fourth in a series, it contains four stories of ordinary people experiencing very strange things--in other words, these are typical "Twilight Zone" tales.
