That's probably the biggest secret to magic: thoroughly learning the mechanics of a trick and spending even more time perfecting its performance. I know because I'm a professional magician and have been teaching magic for almost 27 years.In any event, this book is a good one. If you take the time to sit down and mindfully read it with performance props in hand (e.g., playing cards or whatever), then you'll get something out of it. Any magic book with this many
