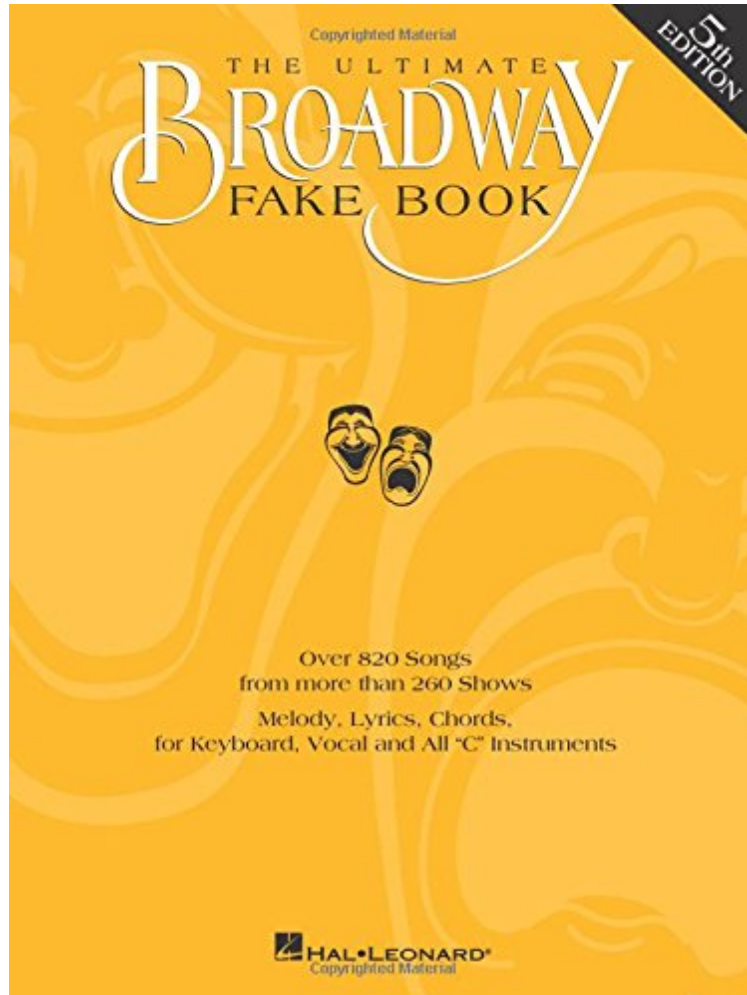

Its very small on a iPad Air, or any 9.5 inch iPad. On my computer I view and use Grab to select a page to print if I need to, RARE. Kindle does not have a print function.
