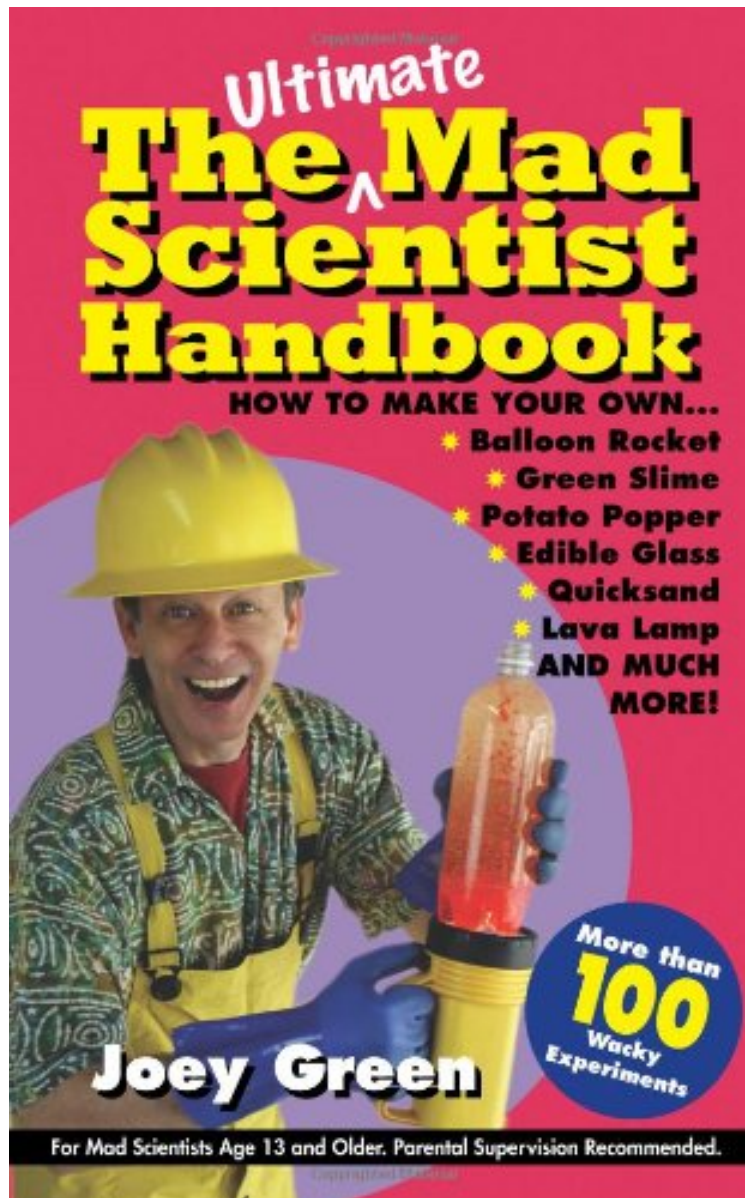

materials or inexpensive items easily available at the grocery store, drug store, or hardware store. I love the "Flying Ping-Pong Ball" to demonstrate Bernoulli's Principle, "Plunger Power," which shows the amazing strength of a vacuum seal, and the "Exploding Rubber Egg," to illustrate osmosis. I tested several of these experiments with my own kids, and they were wowed by "Green Slime," the "Homemade UFO," and the "Lava Lamp." The book also explains in simple terms why each experiment works and provides a miscellany of strange facts pertaining to each experiment.
