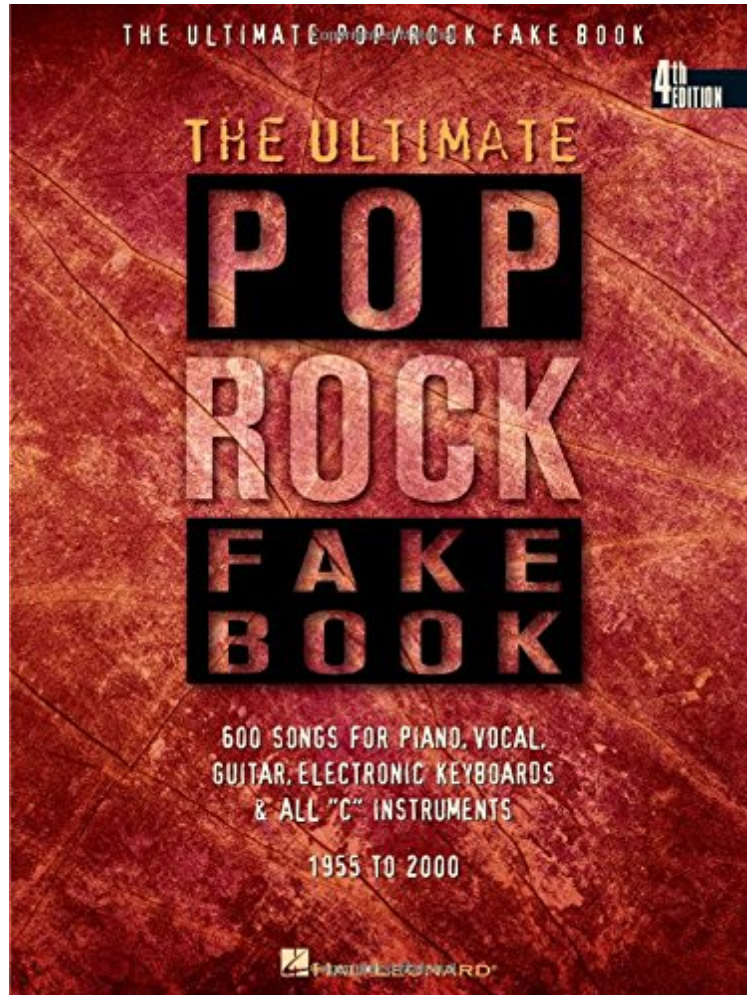

Some of the arrangements with 4 and 5 sharps and flats are very challenging. Transposing some into easier keys would be a huge help. Also, in the effort to have 600 songs, the typeface is fairly small. I could handle it as a 60 year old, but I'm sure older folks will struggle a little.
