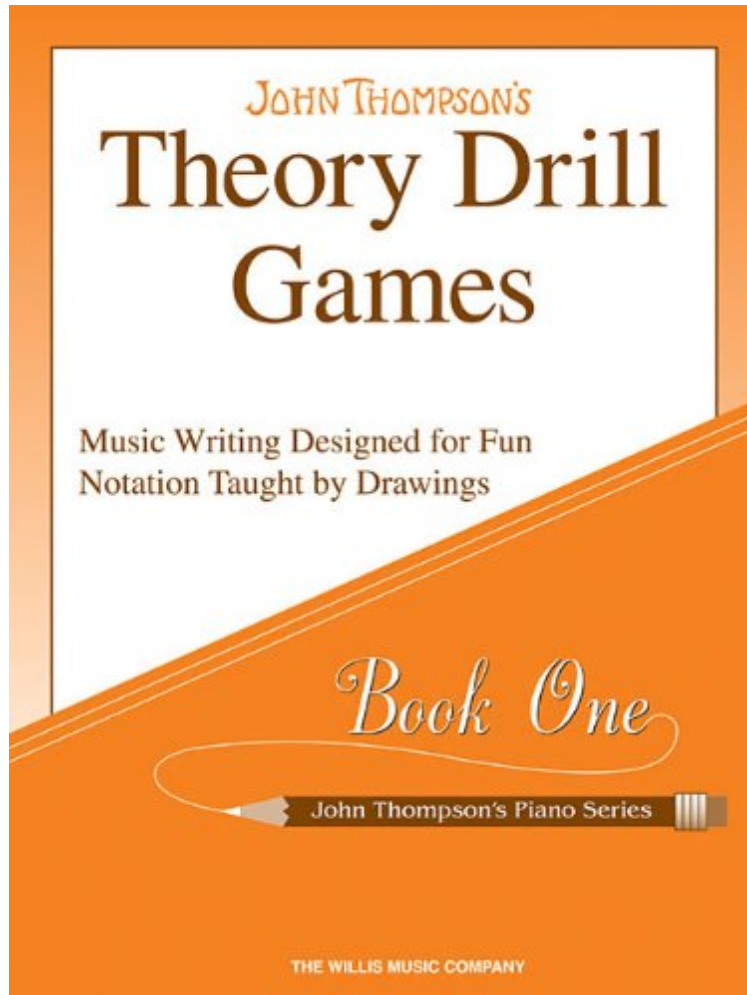

If you are having success with students using John Thompson, this book is a good way to build a strong theory foundation and make up for the lack of theory in the piano method books and has an engaging

I am 77 years old and remember having John Thompson theory pages when I was a child. They were good then, they are good now. I do disagree with the very first page of beginning on "a" rather than middle "c" because it is much easier to associate middle c - everything above is for the right hand, every thing below is the left hand - and for the young student that is all they need to know for awhile. We all know this rule does not hold fast, it does have exceptions. I also would not begin giving note values as to dotted half notes quite so soon. That could be a later lesson. But the book is good and I would recommend it highly.
